

Lake District Hotel Development

Now you need to write up what happened during the debate. Your work must be written up neatly in your assessment books. You should include (at least the following):

- A background - discuss the proposed development, what it will look like, where is it?
- An introduction - explain who was present (the groups).
- Which groups were for/against the development and why?
- What was the final decision, will the hotel be built? What was the best argument?
- A conclusion - what you personally felt about the result - are you happy?

When writing your reports you must include detailed arguments, justifying people's points of view: ie why would a B&B owner lose business. **{Higher marks are given for this}**

Some Tips:

- Write it in the style of a newspaper report, use this type of language...they tend to be very descriptive and give lots of facts.
- Use your notes from the table to help to include lots of detail.
- Try adding some images, maps etc to make it look more professional.
- Think of some catchy titles and layouts.
- Use the mark grid provided to help yourself get a higher grade.
